# **FOLLOW THE WAY Scope and Sequence**

### Matthew 4:19

Jesus called out to them, "Come, follow me."

Way is a 6-part Discipleship Journey that will introduce you to the Story of the Bible and guide you to maturity as a follower of Jesus Christ. **Follow The Way** is based on a discipleship process that is relational, biblical and intentional.

### **DISCOVERY**

Instead of telling you what to believe and how to live, we'll connect you with the Bible so you can discover that on your own with your group. Discovery promotes engagement in the process and ownership of the outcomes.

### **DISCIPLESHIP**

Discipleship is a whole life response to Jesus. It's about following Jesus and His way of life. As you grow in your faith and commitment to Jesus, you'll learn to live your life as if He were in your shoes. Discipleship, then, is about being with Jesus to become like Jesus.

#### **GROUP**

You could go through **Follow The Way** on your own. But you'll get so much more out of it if you work through it with 2 or 3 others. Consider finding a guide to coach you. This guide doesn't have to be an expert in the faith. They just need to be a few steps ahead of you on the journey to point you in the right direction. Here's a thought—After you work through **Follow The Way**, you'll be ready to guide others through it.



Now through faith in Jesus' death and resurrection, when God looks at us He sees His Son. And because Jesus is righteous, God sees us as righteous. FROM ENEMY TO FAMILY (Reconciliation and Adoption)	Romans 5:1-11	Though we were God's enemies because of our sinful rebellion, God has reconciled us to Himself as His friends and has adopted us as His very own children through the death and resurrection of His Son Jesus Christ. ### FREEDOM - Part 6
